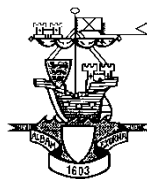

CANLYNIADAU ARHOLIADAU ALLANOL – HAF 2014

Mae'r ysgol yn ymfalchïo yn y canlyniadau Lefel A unwaith eto eleni. 'Roedd y canrannau llwyddiant ar bob lefel yn galonogol iawn Gyda bron i 110 o fyfyrwyr yn derbyn eu canlyniadau Lefel A eleni mae'n braf nodi bod y mwyafrif helaeth ohonynt wedi llwyddo i sicrhau cwrs, o'u dewis cyntaf, mewn Prifysgol, ar gyfer flwyddyn nesaf. Llwyddodd canran uchel iawn o'r flwyddyn i ennill cymhwyster Bagloriaeth Cymru, gan sicrhau mynediad i Addysg Uwch yn sgil y llwyddiant hwn. Mae'r llwyddiant yma yn adlewyrchiad o waith caled myfyrwyr a'r staff i gyd, yn ogystal a chefnogaeth rhieni. Llongyfarchiadau a phob dymuniad da i bob un ohonynt!!

'Roedd y canlyniadau TGAU eleni yn galonogol iawn yn Ysgol David Hughes. 'Rydym yn arbennig o falch **nad** yw unrhyw ddisgybl yn gadael yr ysgol yn ddigymhwyster. Cyrhaeddodd y mwyafrif helaeth o'r disgyblion eu graddau targed. Llwyddodd dros **90%** o ddisgyblion Blwyddyn 11 i ennill cymwysterau sy'n cyfateb i 5 TGAU neu fwy, graddau A*-C. Cafodd bron i **100%** 5 TGAU neu fwy, graddau A*-G. Mae'r canrannau uchod yn sylweddol uwch na'r canrannau cenedlaethol.

Gydag amrediad y cyrsiau sydd ar gael i bobl ifanc yn cynyddu bob blwyddyn, mae'n braf nodi'r llwyddiant eleni yn y pynciau craidd - Cymraeg, Saesneg, Mathemateg a Gwyddoniaeth. With over 110 pupils obtaining A Level results this year, it is heartening to note that the majority of the pupils have been successful in securing places, of their first choice, at University, for the next year. A large majority of the year group attained the Welsh Baccalaureate, which helped to secure admission to Higher Education due to this success. The results reflects the hard work of the individual pupils and all the school staff, and, of course, the support of parents. Congratulations and best wishes to each one of them!

This year's GCSE results at Ysgol David Hughes were very encouraging. We are especially proud that **no** pupil left the school unqualified. The majority of pupils achieved their target grades. Over **90%** of last year's Year 11 pupils attained qualifications equivalent 5 GCSEs at grades A*-C or better. Almost **100%** achieved the equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grades A*-G or better. These percentages are significantly above national comparators.

With a wide range of available courses increasing each year, it is heartening to note the success in the core subjects – Welsh, English, Mathematics and Science. Over **115** students have returned to the Sixth Form – a reflection of the hard work of students and the school staff.

Also, we would like to note our appreciation of Year 11 and Year 13 parents support during the last few years.

Our best wishes to all students who are commencing new university or college courses, or other new career paths.

VISITING SCHOOL

PUNCTUALITY

All pupils are expected to be in school by **8.45am** in order to ensure an orderly start to the school day. Your co-operation is therefore requested at the beginning of a new school year.

Pupils who arrive late in the morning, or are late for lessons, will be kept in detention (initially at lunch-time and then after school).

PUPIL ABSENCE

Regular attendance is essential if pupils are to take full advantage of the educational opportunities presented to them. In order to improve the overall attendance in school, we have adopted a first day contact system using the communication system 'Keep Kids Safe'. The 'Keep Kids Safe at School' system securely sends text messages and/or automated voice broadcasts direct to parents and carers. We have received guidance from the Welsh Assembly Government regarding the above.

We are not in favour of releasing pupils for holidays during the school term. We ask for your co-operation in ensuring that such situations do not arise.

PUPILS' CLINIC – YEARS 9-13

The Pupils' Clinic continues to be held at the school for pupils in Years 9-13. A nurse from the Health Authority is responsible for the clinic and she is able to advise pupils on health matters. This can include a variety of matters for example, healthy eating, smoking, alcohol, sexual issues etc.

If any issues arise that are relevant to the school, these will be referred to the school's management team. The clinic will be held each Tuesday lunchtime 12.30pm-1.30pm. This information will be conveyed to the pupils and they will of course be encouraged to share any sensitive issues with their parents.

SKILLS DAY

A whole school skills day has been arranged for **Tuesday, 7 October 2014**. A purposeful and interesting programme has been organised for all year groups.

Pupils will develop a multitude of valuable skills which will help them to become better learners and enable them to contribute fully to their communities in the future.

SCHOOL EISTEDDFOD

The Eisteddfod for Years 7, 8 and 9 will be held on **Friday, 24 October**.

We encourage all pupils to contribute in order to gain points for their team.

There are many ways in which pupils can participate, including homework, practical work and stage competitions.

MUSIC LESSONS

Peripatetic lessons in percussion, violin, guitar, harp, piano, woodwind, brass instruments and singing lessons are taught at the school. This opportunity is open to all pupils. Please contact the school for further details.

PUPIL BEHAVIOUR

Unfortunately, the poor behaviour of a small minority of pupils can affect the progress, enjoyment and safety of other pupils. We are determined to ensure that this small minority does not adversely affect the education of the majority.

1. BEHAVIOUR IN LESSONS AND ON THE CORRIDORS

Pupils are fully aware of the school's expectations and the need to show respect towards members of staff, other pupils and the building. We intend to contact you, as parents, if any pupil cannot conform to these basic rules. **Continued misbehaviour could result in an internal exclusion in school.**

2. SCHOOL BUSES

The behaviour of some pupils on the school buses has been unacceptable. Following discussions with the Education Authority and the bus companies it is likely that the **bus companies will refuse to transport certain individuals to and from school**. The responsibility for transport arrangements will then rest with parents.

No smoking on the buses – pupils are to remain seated throughout the journey.

3. SAFETY ON THE YARD WHEN THE BUSES ARRIVE IN THE MORNING

Due to the safety issues when the buses arrive between 8.20-8.40, pupils are requested to leave the front yard immediately after they arrive on site.

4. DRUGS/ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES

We will not tolerate the presence of illegal substances on the school premises. Any pupil involved in the possession or distribution of illegal substances faces permanent exclusion from Ysgol David Hughes.

5. MOBILE PHONES/PERSONAL MUSIC/MP3 PLAYERS/CAMERAS

Due to the problems that mobile phones can cause during lessons and examinations, **they are not, under any circumstances, to be brought into the school.**

Pupils are not allowed to bring personal music/MP3 players/cameras to school. If this rule is not adhered to then staff will confiscate the item and contact the parents. These items are also a target for thieves.

Thank you for your co-operation.

LEAVING THE SCHOOL GROUNDS

Pupils in Years 7-11 are not allowed to leave the school grounds during the morning break.

Only Year 10/11/12/13 pupils are allowed outside of the school grounds at lunch time and only if they have parental consent.

Pupils do not have permission to leave the school grounds once they have been dropped off by the buses first thing in the morning.

DETENTION

Schools have the legal authority to detain pupils on disciplinary grounds after the end of a school session without the consent of parents. The school must give at least 24 hours notice before the detention takes place and we will, of course, take account of any special circumstances applying to individual pupils.

SMOKE-FREE SCHOOL

We would like to remind you that smoking is prohibited within the school building and on the school grounds. Smoking is not permitted on the school minibus or school buses either. Smoking in these areas is now against the law. If pupils are caught smoking, the school will contact their parents.

SCHOOL MEALS

'Caterlink' catering company has informed us that the price of school meals will increase from **1 September 2014**, to £2.15 for full meal (two courses).

ARRANGEMENTS IN AN EMERGENCY

CLOSING THE SCHOOL

The arrangements will depend on the nature of the emergency but the safety of the pupils and school staff will be our priority at all times.

These are the steps that will be taken within the school:

1. We intend to send you a text message if the school closes in an emergency.
2. Pupils will be gathered together in year groups at different assembly points in the school.
3. We will arrange for the buses to come to the school to collect the pupils.
4. The following radio stations will be notified that the school is to close:-
BBC Radio Cymru, Radio Wales and Heart FM.
5. Parents are also advised to check the school website for any information regarding closing the school – www.ysgoldavidhughes.org.
6. The pupils will be informed that they are **not to leave the school (walking or on a bus) unless they have entry to their homes or a close relative/friend's home (according to the family's arrangements)**.
7. The pupils will be called to the buses, one bus at a time.
8. The school minibus will be used to transport some pupils home if necessary.

This type of situation is very rare, and we appreciate your support when decisions have to be made quickly in an emergency. We can assure you that the pupils' safety is our priority at all times.

We would like to draw your attention to point 6 above in particular, which emphasizes the need for pupils to be clear about the arrangements 'at home' in an emergency situation.

Please ensure that your child is fully aware of the procedures that you wish them to follow in such an emergency.

We emphasize once again that pupils should not leave the school site if they do not have entry to their homes or a relative/close friend's home, as arranged by you beforehand. Alternatively, we will ensure that the pupils are safe at the school until you have made arrangements for them to go home.
