

A group of pupils represented the school in Llandudno in the Techocamps Robotics Competition. The pupils had been working hard to design and build a robot that searched for and destroyed landmines. The robot has been designed to be used in countries where landmines cause death and injuries to people. The robot was aptly named the Ter-mine-ator. During the day the pupils demonstrated their robot, along with a poster and video to a team of judges. As a surprise to the students, there was a secret challenge set to the group where they were given an hour to rebuild their robot and take part in a face-off against a robot from another school. The judges were very happy with the Ter-terminator robot demonstration, stating the fact that its effect on humans provided was a very positive appeal, and awarded the group second place in the North Wales competition.
