Obituary to Lucy Beesley 1991 - 2017

The school has been informed of the immensely sad news of the death of Lucy Beesley. Lucy attended David Hughes School from 2004 until 2010. Excelling in athletics, at the age of 15, she represented Anglesey at the Island Games in Rhodes in 2007 where she won the silver in the 100m in a time of just 12.29 seconds. Diagnosed with an in-operable brain tumour in December 2010, she initially responded well to treatment and was in remission for 5 years. Despite the difficulties associated with her treatment, and with typical determination, Lucy led a full and active life graduating from Bangor University in 2015 with a 2.1 hon. BA in Childhood studies and once again represented Anglesey at the Island Games in Bemuda in 2013 and again in Jersey in 2015. Tragically her tumour reappeared in October 2015 and despite continuing treatment the progression of her illness could not be checked. She died at home last Sunday, 19th March, in the loving care of her family. Lucy will be hugely missed by her family and many friends.
